Combining multi-stakeholder dialogue, **peer learning** and in-region expertise towards forging **connections** and **coalitions**, utilising **member-driven** learning agenda

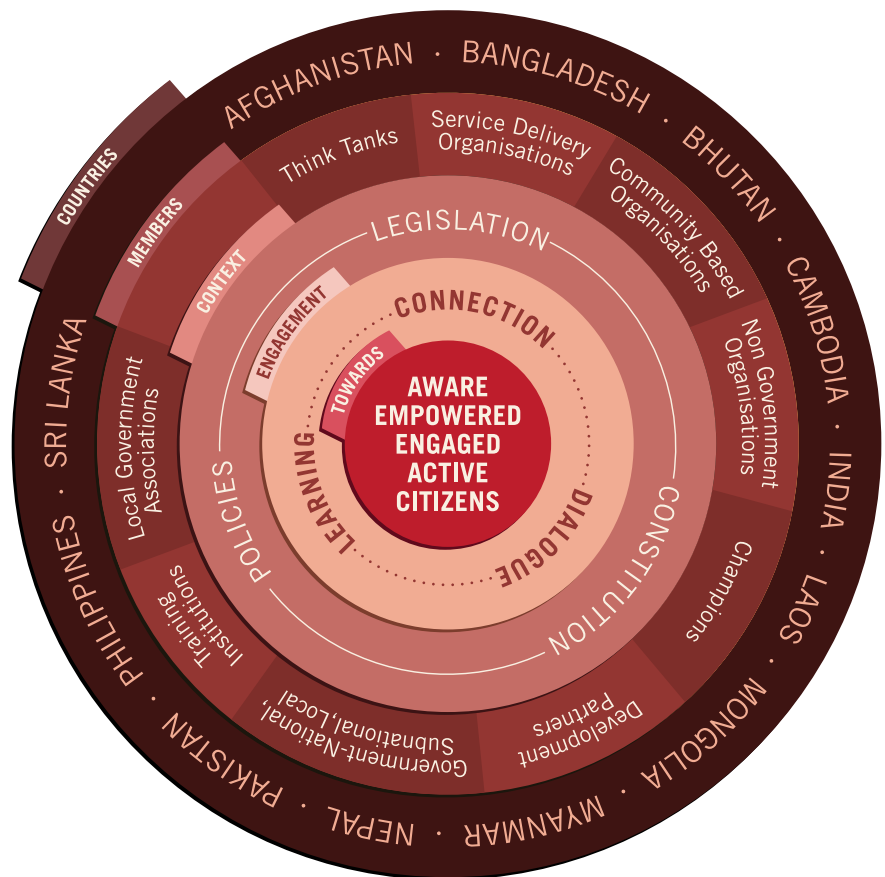

Opportunity to collaborate as a development partner with local governments via modalities such as public private partnerships, towards citizen-responsive service delivery

Scope for leveraging partnerships incubated within the Network to improve scale and sustainability of investments in effective local governance

Opportunity to inform and be informed beyond the immediate ecosystem of respective grantees and partners

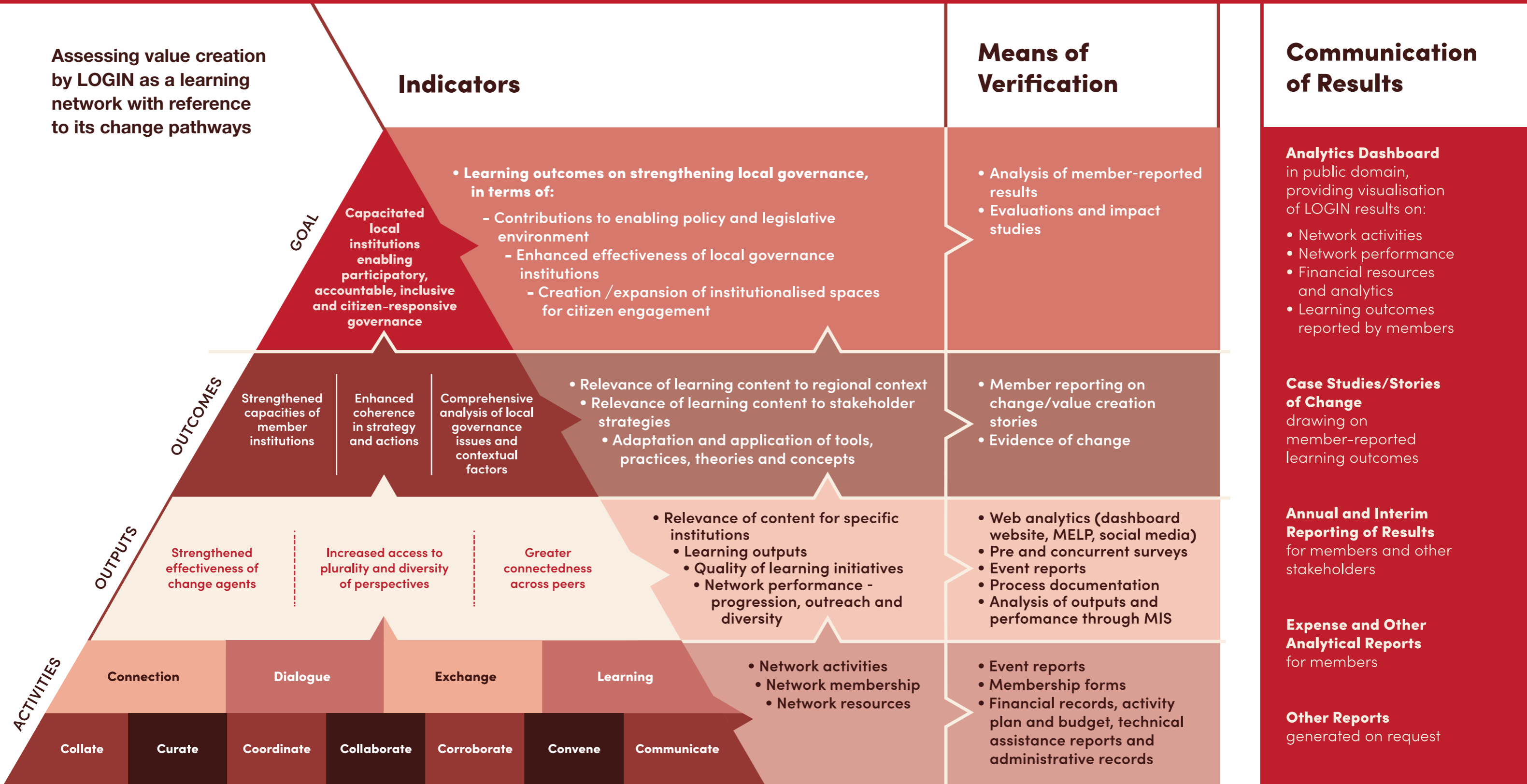

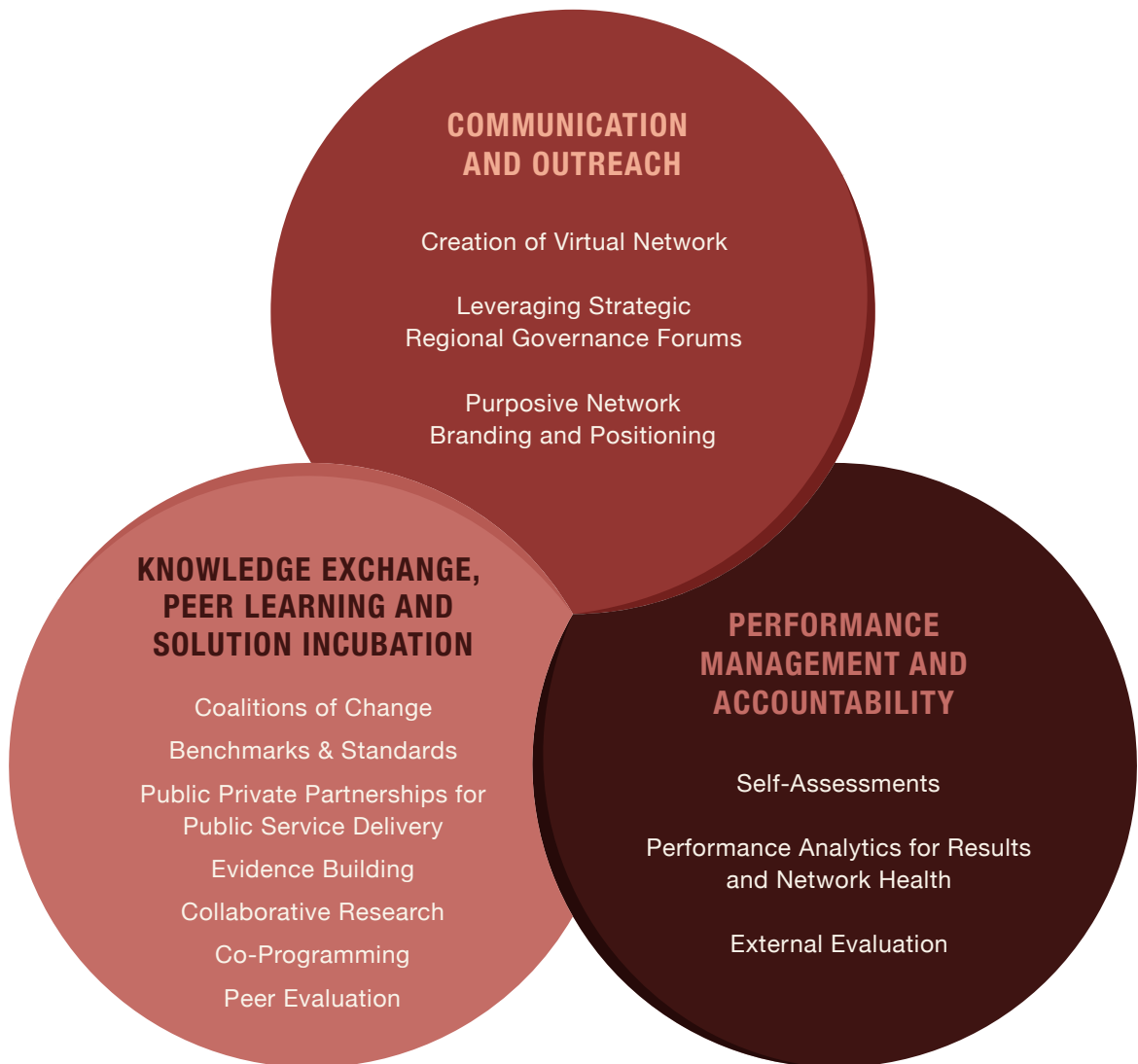
